Marble busts are a fixture of many a stately home. Glasgow's Holmwood House, designed by architect Alexander Thomson in the mid-1800s and now run by the National Trust for Scotland, has an abundance thanks to an installation by Liverpool-born artist Jonathan Owen. He subtly reconfigures Victorian statues –

altering faces and gestures; creating interactions between one figure and the next – to disconcerting effect.
