

JONATHAN OWEN

Jonathan Owen's work involves the systematic transformation of readymade objects and images, using materially reductive processes. He is interested in making by removing, and the controlled collapse of existing objects as a method of production and reactivation.

Owen's drawings begin as photographs found in books. In painstakingly erasing parts of the original image he creates a new narrative within the image, leaving a ghostly echo of what was there before. His recent sculptures work in a similar way; found marble statues and reliefs are intricately re-carved to create an elegantly disjointed version of the original form, presenting an unsolvable yet innately intriguing puzzle.

Jonathan Owen exhibited at the Scottish National Gallery of Modern Art in 2014 as part of the nationwide *GENERATION* series of exhibitions, profiling the best contemporary art in Scotland over the past 25 years. Owen's solo exhibition at Ingleby Gallery from 28 July – 28 August 2016 accompanied and contextualised his major public artwork for the nearby Burns Monument; commissioned by Edinburgh Art Festival 2016, Owen's re-carved 19th Century marble nymph stood in the circular neo-classical pavilion which was originally intended to house Flaxman's life-size portrait of Robert Burns. This sculpture will be exhibited in 2017 as part of the National Gallery of Victoria Triennial, Australia. Owen's first major monograph with texts by Sorcha Carey and Maria Fusco was published by Ingleby Gallery in July 2016.
