

PETER LIVERSIDGE

Peter Liversidge's diverse body of work exists in almost every conceivable medium: drawing, performance, installation, photography, painting, sculpture, interventions, artist's books and multiples. While his work has an assured lightness of touch and a quiet poeticism, there is often an underlying streak of darker, absurdist humour.

A central aspect of Liversidge's practice is the making of Proposals, groups of hand-typed and posted suggestions that range from the sublime to the ridiculous, forming the basis for exhibitions, works and performances. Some of the proposals are realised, leading to artworks, performances and events. Others exist solely as ideas on A4 pieces of paper.

Since 2006, Liversidge has worked with institutions across Europe, including the Tate Gallery, Liverpool; The Scottish National Gallery of Modern Art and the National Gallery of Finland. In 2013 the artist exhibited as part of the group exhibition *The Spirit of Utopia* at the Whitechapel Gallery, London and was commissioned to create a new public artwork for the Edinburgh Art Festival: *Flags for Edinburgh*. Major solo exhibitions have recently been presented at i8 Gallery; Reykjavik; The MAC, Belfast and Basis, Frankfurt. In 2015 Liversidge's exhibition *Notes on Protesting* was presented at Whitechapel Gallery, London and a solo presentation was on display at the Van Abbe Museum, The Netherlands in the Winter. In 2016 Liversidge was artist in residence for TedXCoutauldInstitute programme *Utopia: Breaking the Rules*. The artist's first solo museum exhibition in the USA was presented at the Aldrich Museum, Connecticut from 1 May 2016 – 5 February, 2017. *The Bridge* a unique cycle of songs was written by Liversidge in response to Tate Modern's building, its history and its place in contemporary life was performed on in June 2016.
